The SOSpesa experience allowed to test a collection-redistribution-transformation cycle, of both food surpluses and fresh food purchased at controlled prices.

SOSpesa+ aims at enhancing and potentiating the results of the previous project, thanks to an innovative model of municipal market where the food supply chain and the activation of citizens are at the center of the services that are being offered. The vision extends to a broader rethinking of the functions of municipal markets as hubs of urban food supply chains.

SOSpesa+ also proposes a new volunteering model, food education initiatives and a neighborhood composter.
