art. 1

Award characteristics and recipients

The award of € 1.085,00 gross amounts and with deductible expenses excluded charged to Politecnico di Milano, will be given to the best graduation work among those presented on the topic *Complex Architecture Projects, expression of cultural and ethics awareness and high technical knowledge*

Graduate students, in the session between **April 2016 – April 2018**, can participate, in the following Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programmes of the School of Architecture Urban Planning Construction Engineering:

How to participate

Candidates are required to submit single application form, through the dedicated function available from On-line services <http://www.polimi.it/en/onlineservices> (Exemptions and partnership agreements -> Student bursaries, degree awards, exemptions) **within 12.00 noon (Italian time) of 08 May 2018.**

Candidates must **submit**, through specific procedure:

- the **graduation work abstract** in A4 vertical format in pdf of maximum 10MB;
- **the slides** of the graduation project of maximum 20 MB.

The files must be named with Surname-Name-Kind of document.pdf (for example Rossi-Mario-abstract.pdf)

The closure of the on-line application is equivalent to send the participation application for this Call and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is responsibility of the candidate to verify the correct conclusion of the procedure.

After closure of the Notice, application cannot be changed any more. The candidate can delete the application and resubmit a new one before the Call deadline.

Failure to close the application or its incompleteness will implies the exclusion from the evaluation procedure.

In case of graduation work **with multiple authors, each co-author, that wants to participate** to allocation of the award, **must submit individually the application form.**

If, provided that conditions under Art. 1 of this Call are met, more than one candidate has equivalent qualifications, the Committee could allocate, among them, the amount of the award.

art. 3

Judging Panel

The awarding will be decided by a Judging Panel appointed after Call deadline by Executive Decree.

The Selection Commission, for the allocation of the degree award, will evaluate only the attachments uploaded via the appropriate procedure.

If the Selection Commission considers that none of the graduation works presented by the candidates can be considered eligible for the award, it will not be assigned.

art. 4
General Rules

Cumulability: the degree award cannot be added to other prizes awarded for the same degree thesis.

Withdrawal: if the winner waives the degree award, the prize will be assigned to the next candidate in the ranking list.

Award: the degree prize is paid in one instalment. The winner will be informed of the degree prize award via an e-mail sent to his/her university e-mail address after the publication of the final student ranking list. No later than 10 days from receiving the e-mail, the winners must sign and send the specific forms they will find attached to the award notification.

Taxation: the prize awarded is subject to the current laws governing the taxation of scholarships and degree prize. For taxation purposes, the sum paid for the degree prize is to be treated as income comparable to income from employment. The tax due by the Politecnico di Milano is IRAP (equal to 8.5% of the value of the degree prize).
