HAVING REGARD TO the Regulations for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued with Rectoral Decree n. 828 prot.n.7766 of 14/03/2014, and specifically articles 75 and 79;

HAVING REGARD TO Rectoral Decree no. 63/AG of 24/12/1999 which issued the Regulations of the "Prof. Ottorino Sesini" degree award;

HAVING REGARD TO the minutes of the meeting of the Judging Panel of the "Prof. Ottorino Sesini" degree award dated 21/11/2017;

HEREBY DECREES

the issue of the call for applications for no. 1 degree award "Prof. Ottorino Sesini" – year 2017

art. 1

Award characteristics and recipients

The "Prof. Ottorino Sesini" degree award (€1,500.00 before tax and after taxes owed by the Politecnico di Milano) is for graduates who completed a Master's Degree in Mechanical Engineering – Ingegneria Meccanica and sat their degree exam at the Politecnico di Milano between May 2017 and April 2018.

The average exam mark must be no less than 27 out of 30, attributing an additional score of 3 points out of 30 for each awarding of honours.

The Area Sviluppo e Rapporti con le Imprese will check the applicants meet the required criteria.

Participation procedures

Applicants must submit their request for participation through the specific section in the Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **no later than 12.00 pm (midday - Rome time) on 31 August 2018.**

Applicants must attach, through the specific procedure:

- the final degree project pdf format, maximum 10 MB
- a summary (no more than 4 pages) in pdf format, maximum 10 MB

The files must be named as Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Rossi-Mario-Tesi.pdf)

The application is complete with the submission of the request for participation in this call for applications and implies the acceptance of its rules and regulations. Applicants are responsible for checking the procedure is properly completed.

Once the application has been completed and submitted can be printed a receipt and the application may no longer be changed. Applicants will be allowed to delete the request and submit it again (ex novo) before the deadline.

Failure to complete the application or to submit it means applicants will be excluded from the selection process.

In case of theses with more than one author, each co-author who intends to compete for the award will submit a separate application.

Judging Panel

The student ranking list will be awarded by a Judging Panel designated after the expiration date of the call by a Decree of the Manager.

The Panel will create the ranking list on the basis of the applicants' curriculum and degree thesis.

In case of an ex-aequo, the Judging Panel will award the prize to the candidate whose thesis addressed a matter relating to Applied Mechanics in Mechanical Engineering, provided the conditions referred to in art. 1 of the call are met.

If several applicants have equivalent qualifications, the Panel may distribute the prize among them. The Panel may decide not to award the prize.

art. 4
General rules

Cumulability: the degree award cannot be added to other prizes awarded for the same degree thesis.

Renunciation: if the winner renounces the prize, it will be awarded to the next highest ranking applicant in the ranking list.

Award: the degree award is paid in one instalment. The winner will be informed of the degree prize award via an e-mail sent to his/her university e-mail address after the publication of the final student ranking list. No later than 10 days from receiving the e-mail, the winners must sign and send the specific forms they will find attached to the award notification.

Taxation: the prize awarded is subject to the current laws governing the taxation of scholarships and degree prize. For taxation purposes, the sum paid for the degree prize is to be treated as income comparable to income from employment. The tax due by the Politecnico di Milano is IRAP (equal to 8.5% of the value of the degree prize).

No award: if the degree award is not awarded, for whatever reason, its amount will increase the capital of the fund.

INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

Through this document, the Politecnico di Milano (hereinafter also called Polytechnic), as Data Controller, with offices located in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management -, informs you with regard to the processing of your personal data, in compliance to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council dated 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals regarding the processing of personal data and related implementing legislation (hereinafter also called the Regulations).

The Data Processor, of the data provided by you, is the Director of the Area Sviluppo e Rapporti con le Imprese.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data collected and processed by the Polytechnic, which regards you, is the following: **(a)** the data you communicated at the time of registration or enrollment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, social security number, nationality, address of residence, telephone and IT addresses, qualifications; **(b)** the data collected at the time of submission of the application, in particular the data relating to your academic career, qualification achieved, as well as the data contained in your final degree project.

B. PURPOSE AND METHOD OF PROCESSING

Your personal data may be processed:

1. to verify eligibility requirements to participate in the competition according to the criteria set out in this announcement and for any other purpose required by law, also with the aim of processing statistical information.

In relation to the aforementioned purposes, data processing by the Politecnico di Milano will take place using manual, computerized and electronic tools in a relevant manner and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which they are processed and, in any case, in order to guarantee the maximum security and confidentiality and, always, in full compliance with the legislation in force. The Politecnico will take all measures to promptly correct inaccurate data in relation to the processing purposes.

With reference to the particular data, the processing will be carried out in a proportionate manner with regard to the aim pursued, while adopting appropriate and specific measures to protect your fundamental rights.

C. COMPULSORY AND NON-COMPULSORY DATA

Providing data, for the purposes referred to in paragraph B. point 1, is mandatory and any refusal to provide such data involves the inadmissibility of the application submitted by the student and the immediate exclusion from the procedure. Providing data for the purposes referred to in paragraph B. point 2 is optional and any refusal to provide data does not lead to any consequences.

D. DATA CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION

Your personal data will be passed on to the Polytechnic employees who will be authorized to process this data, or to natural or legal persons who provide consulting services or

collaborate with the Polytechnic for the purpose of providing the selection procedures as foreseen by the competition announcement.

E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at the Politecnico di Milano. Your data will not be transferred to a third country.

F. PERSONAL DATA PERIOD OF RETENTION

Your personal data will be kept for the time strictly necessary to guarantee access to the right to study benefits, unless the retention of data for a longer period is necessary for archiving purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research or for statistical purposes. Should data retention be needed for longer periods, the Polytechnic guarantees compliance with the principle of data minimization pursuant to art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

We would like to remind you that you have the right:

- to obtain information in relation to the ways in which your data is processed and any other information required by art. 15 of the Regulations (right of access)
- to obtain the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 16 of the Regulations (rectification right)
- to obtain a limitation on the processing of personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 18 of the Regulations (processing restriction right);
- to oppose the processing of your personal data in the cases and under the conditions provided for by art. 21 of the Regulations (right of opposition)
