the issuance of the call for applications for the "**Michele Silvers**" degree award - **year 2020**.

Art. 1

Characteristics of the award and recipients

One award, having the value of **€1,800.00**, will be granted to the degree thesis considered the best among those submitted on the topic of *Architecture Designs in international contexts* which was developed abroad.

A second award of **€700.00** and a third award of **€500.00** may be granted to theses which discuss the matter in an original manner. In addition, two honorary mentions and three mentions are envisaged.

The above amounts are gross and are net of costs to be paid by Politecnico di Milano. Graduates may participate in the period **1 January 2020 – 31 December 2020** in the following Master's degree courses of the School of Architecture Urban Planning Construction Engineering:

- Architecture-Architectural Design
- Architecture
- Architecture and Urban Design
- Architecture - Built Environment Interiors
- Architecture - Construction Architecture
- Architectural Design and History
- Sustainable Architecture and Landscape Design
- Building Engineering - Architecture (single-cycle five-year course)

Art. 2 **How to participate**

Applicants are required to submit the individual application by way of the specific function available from online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici [Subsidies and Conventions > Scholarships, degree awards, exonerations, generic notices]) **by 12pm (Italian time) on 18 January 2021.**

Applicants must **include**, in the specific procedure, **the link to a folder on their One Drive – Politecnico di Milano** which must contain:

- 1. Abstract of the thesis** in English in vertical A4 format of max 2,000 characters, spaces included, in PDF format. The abstract must be preceded by the title of the thesis / name of the author(s) / name of the supervisor (see attached template).
- 2. no. 3 tables** in horizontal A1 format 59.4 x 84.1 cm, saved in low definition PDF max. 10 MB each (see attached template in Illustrator PDF format). The high definition tables may be requested later.

The tables will be organised as follows:

- 1) **“Manifest” table** containing a single image, in grey scale, full page, which must represent the thesis design as closely as possible (see attached template).
- 2) **“Concept + contents” table.** The table, split into two columns (single module on the left = 1/3 of the total width; double module on the right = 2/3 of the total width), will contain in the single module the illustration of the design Concept, through drawings, diagrams and sketches, while the double module will contain a selection of drawings and images significant to the narration of the design (see attached template).
- 3) **“Contents + final views” table.** The table, split into two columns (double module on the left = 2/3 of the total width; single module on the right = 1/3 of the total width) will contain in the double module the development of the contents, through representative drawings and images and, in the single module, a collection of three-dimensional images, 3D views or photos of the model (see attached template).

3. no. 1 mp4 format video, duration max 1 minute summarising the design, in low definition. The video may be created as an animation or as a slide show and must be introduced by the home screen containing the title of the design and any subtitle, names and surnames of the authors and the abstract of 200 characters, spaces included (see attached template).

Video specifications:

File H.264 Codec exported into Mp4, max SD (Standard definition) resolution.

4. Thesis booklet in low definition PDF format (max. 50 MB). The high definition file may be requested later.).

5. A4 model sheet, PDF format, containing no. 4 images of the created model and its dimensions (see attached template).

If no model has been created, the sheet should not be completed.

The One Drive folder, containing the attachments useful for the assessment, must be named with the Surname-First Name of the applicant.

The files must be named with Surname-First Name-Document Type.format (for example, Rossi-Mario-abstract.pdf)

Please check that the link to the One Drive folder can actually be used by the Committee, that it has no expiry date and no access restrictions and that it is not damaged.

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that they have properly completed the procedure.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be edited. The applicant may delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this call.

The following circumstances shall involve exclusion from the assessment procedure:

failure to close the application and/or incompleteness of the same;

inadequacy of the documents submitted;

an unusable link.

For **theses with several authors, each co-author intending to compete** for the award **must present individually** their application for participation.

By submitting the application, **the applicant consents to the material** submitted or part of it being **disseminated in** respect of copyright.

Art. 3 **Selection Committee**

The granting of award will be decided by a Selection Committee appointed after the expiry of the call by managerial decree.

The Committee's works will take place in two phases:

- **First phase:** the Committee will carry out an initial selection of applicants;
- **Second phase:** the winners of the award will be chosen from the applicants identified in the first phase

The Selection Committee, for the purposes of assigning the degree award, will assess exclusively the attachments uploaded via the specific procedure.

If the Selection Committee considers that none of the theses submitted by the competitors are suitable, the award will not be granted.

If, on the condition the requirements set out in Art. 1 of the call are in place, several competitors are in possession of equivalent qualifications, the Committee may assign *ex aequo* and split the amount of the award into equal parts between the winners.

If the Committee decides not to assign one or both of the awards of €700.00 and of €500.00, that/those amount(s) will go towards increasing the sum allocated for the first award granted for the best degree thesis.

Art. 4 **Award assignment**

The assignment of the “Michele Silvers” degree award will occur through an online ceremony on **11 March 2021**, during which the winning designs will be announced along with those mentioned by the Selection Committee.

All candidates are expected to attend the online ceremony.

Commencing from **29 March 2021** a digital contribution, distributed via the University's channels, will present the outcomes of the “Michele Silvers” award on the occasion of its Tenth edition.

Art.5 **General rules**

Accumulation: the degree award cannot be accumulated with other awards received for the same thesis.

Withdrawal/refusal: if the winner withdraws their application or refuses the prize, the prize will be awarded to the applicant immediately below them in the ranking.

Payment: the award will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano. The assignment of the award will be communicated to the winners at the institutional email address of the University. Within 10 days of receipt of this communication, the winners must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

Tax status: the payments awarded are subject to taxation, under the legislation in force regarding study awards. The amount paid as a degree award is income considered similar to income from employment, and as such is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate amounting to 8.5% of the amount of the scholarship.

Art. 6 **Manager responsible for the selection process**
