HAVING REGARD to Presidential Decree 28.12.2000, no. 445;
HAVING REGARD to Articles 2 and 12 of Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, “Equal treatment in the right to university studies”;
HAVING REGARD to the Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued by Rector’s Decree no. 828 ref. no. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and in particular Art. 75 and 79;
HAVING REGARD to the sponsorship contract ref. no. 29510 dated 22/02/2021 signed with IL SOLE 24 ORE EVENTI S.R.L., for the payment of a total contribution of €20,000.00 in favour of Politecnico di Milano aimed at the provision of scholarships for worthy female students on master’s degree courses in Engineering at Politecnico to encourage their orientation towards study paths and careers in the STEM field;
HAVING REGARD to the Regulation for performances on behalf of third parties, issued with Rector’s Decree no. 5803 dated 19/02/2014, as amended;

DECREES

The issuance of the call **for 1 scholarship** known as
“STEM 4 Women @Gruppo 24 ORE” a.y. 2021/2022.

Art. 1

Characteristics of the study scholarship and recipients

No. 1 scholarship, in the gross amount of **€8,000.00** including costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, is intended for female students enrolled for the first time in the a.y. 2021/2022 on master’s degree courses in Engineering at Politecnico di Milano.

The study scholarship **is renewable** for the same amount for the next academic year if the requirements are met as envisaged by Art. 5 of this call.

Art. 2

Participation requirements

The study scholarship is intended for female students who, by the deadline of the call:

- are enrolled for the first time in the a.y. 2021/2022 on one of the following master’s degree courses at Politecnico di Milano:

Automation and Control Engineering
Computer Science and Engineering
Electrical Engineering

- have taken and duly recorded in their career **at least 15 CFU** useful for achieving the qualification;
- have a weighted average of exams taken and recorded of **not less than 24/30**
- were registered on a (first level) degree course in Engineering at Politecnico di Milano in the a.y. 2018/2019 and gained the respective qualification in the a.y. 2020/2021;

The Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division will ascertain possession of the requirements present in the IT archive of Politecnico di Milano.

Art. 4 **Participation procedures**

Applicants must submit the application using the specific function available from online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici [Subsidies and Conventions > Scholarships, degree prizes, exonerations, generic notices]) **by 12pm (Italian time) on 31 March 2022.**

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a new one before the deadline set out in this call for applications.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

Art. 5 **Scholarship assignment**

The assignment of the scholarship is decided based upon a ranking drawn up by the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

The ranking will be formulated based upon the score determined by the formula:

**(WEIGHTED AVERAGE x ECTS RECORDED) + ECONOMIC CONDITION
SCORE (at the Call deadline)**

The economic condition score is determined as follows:

2021 EQUIVALENT ECONOMIC SITUATION INDICATOR (ISEE)/UNIVERSITY EQUIVALENT ECONOMIC SITUATION INDICATOR (ISEEU) VALUE	SCORE
from €0 to €23,120	100
from €23,121 to €27,000	100
from €27,001 to €31,000	90
from €31,001 to €40,000	80
from €40,001 to €51,000	70
from €51,001 to €63,000	70
from €63,001 to €75,000	50
from €75,001 to €95,000	50
from €95,001 to higher amounts	25

To that end, the **valid and compliant 2022 ISEE (equivalent ISEEU** for those not earning income in Italy), found in the University's **database by the call deadline** will be considered.

In the absence of a valid and compliant **2022 ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator)/ISEEU** the student will be **attributed**, solely for the purposes of this ranking, the **highest ISEE/ISEEU (€95,001)**.

If the applicants are still equal, priority will be given to the youngest applicant.

The scholarship may not be assigned if none of the applicants are considered suitable.

The winner may be invited to a meet-and-greet with the donor.

Art. 6 **Renewal of the scholarship**

The winner of the "**STEM 4 Women @Gruppo 24 ORE**" scholarship for the a.y. 2021/2022 may obtain the renewal of the scholarship for the next academic year if the requirements indicated below are met, maintaining a weighted average of no less than **24/30**:

1st renewal: **enrolment to a.y. 2022/2023** on a degree course in Engineering indicated in Art. 3 by the deadline scheduled in the academic year calendar

taking and recording in the career at least **35 ECTS** useful for achieving the qualification scheduled by the study plan by **30/09/2022**

The aforementioned requirements will be verified by the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division allowing for the automatic renewal of the scholarship.

Art. 7 **General rules**

Combinations - The scholarship cannot be combined with others or other forms of financial aid provided by Politecnico for the same academic year of reference of this call for applications. **The scholarship may be combined with the Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits**, and international mobility contributions provided by Politecnico or other public or private entities. The scholarship may also be combined with exemptions from mandatory university fees and contributions.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

Waiver: if the winner waives and/or fails to return the necessary forms, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Payment: the assignment of the scholarship and any renewal will be communicated to the winner at the University's institutional email address. Within 10 days from the receipt of this communication, the winner must send the specific forms that she receives attached to the award and renewal notification, signed for acceptance.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not paid in view of the failure by the person entitled to renew the same, the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship award is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

Art. 8 **Person responsible for the selection process**

Under art. 5 of Law, 7 August 1990, no. 241, the Head of this call for applications procedure is Dr Ivano Ciceri.

PRIVACY POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (henceforth **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, informs you of the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementation regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** the data collected upon submitting your application, particularly those relating to your academic career and economic condition.

B. PURPOSES AND METHODS OF PROCESSING

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in section B point 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide them will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. SCOPE OF CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call. **Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.**

If any contact is made by the donor, **the latter will be understood to be a separate and autonomous controller** of data processing. Therefore, the donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (*rectification right*)

restrict the processing of your personal data under Art. 18 of the Regulation (*right to limit processing*);

object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
