**HAVING REGARD** to Article 75, paragraph 2, of the Politecnico di Milano Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued with Rector's Decree no. 828 ref. no. 7766 of 14/03/2014;

**HAVING REGARD** to letter ref. 0101658 of 14/04/2022 with which Giovanna Tomassi expressed the wish to donate the total sum of € 2,712.50 to the Politecnico di Milano purely as a gift in order to establish the 'Stefano Gatti' degree prize for Laurea Magistrale graduates at the Politecnico di Milano with preference for courses in Electronic or Computer Engineering;

**HAVING REGARD** to Managerial Decree No 3834/2022 Ref. 104906 of 20/04/2022 accepting the donation made by Giovanna Tomassi;

### **HEREBY DECREES**

The issue of the call for **1 degree prize 'Ing. Stefano Gatti' 2022**.

#### **Art.1 Premise**

Stefano Gatti was an Alumnus at the Politecnico di Milano, where he graduated in electronic engineering in 1977.

Stefano was a curious person, passionate about knowledge that was not an end in itself, but to be shared with his children, friends and colleagues. His career has been founded on continuous cultural and professional evolution, maintaining ties with the university featuring constant interest in applied research and the development of information technology.

In his memory and thanks to the donation by his family, we are launching this prize in his name.

## **Art. 2** **Description of the degree prize and recipients**

The degree prize, worth € **2,500.00** gross each and net of the charges to be paid by the Politecnico di Milano, shall be awarded for the best degree thesis on subjects related to: *“Sistemi elettronici dedicati in dispositivi logici programmabili” (Special electronic systems in programmable logic devices)*

The call is open to students who have graduated with Laurea Magistrale at the Politecnico di Milano:

- in Electronics Engineering - Ingegneria Elettronica
- in Computer Science and Engineering - Ingegneria Informatica
- in the period April 2021 to July 2022
- with a degree score of at least 100/110

The Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division shall ascertain whether the requirements are met in the Politecnico di Milano computerised archive.

## **Art. 3** **How to participate**

Applicants must submit the application via the procedure found in the Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici [Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits]) **by 12 pm (Italian time) on 06 August 2022.**

Applicants **must attach**, through the appropriate procedure:

1. **their thesis** in PDF format, maximum 15 MB
2. **a letter of presentation of the thesis highlighting the distinguishing points** of the paper and **the reasons why it is deserving of the award** (maximum two A4 pages in Italian or English) in PDF format, maximum 5 MB

The file must be named in the format Surname-Forename-Type of document.pdf (for example Smith-John-Thesis.pdf)

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a new one at any time before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

**In the case of multi-author theses, each co-author wishing to compete for the award shall submit an application individually.**

In this case, all authors must submit identical documentation, as requested in Art. 2.

#### **Art. 4** **Selection Board**

The awarding of the degree prize is decided on the basis of a ranking drawn up by a Selection Board appointed by managerial decree after the deadline of the call for applications.

In formulating the ranking, the Board shall decide on the basis of the attachments uploaded through the appropriate procedure and their relevance and relevance to the topics indicated in Article 1.

Provided that the requirements set out in Article 1 of the call for applications are met, the Board may divide the award among several candidates in the event of a tie.

If the applicants prove ineligible, the Selection Board may choose not to assign the award.

The winners may be invited to a meet-and-greet with the donor.

#### **Art. 5** **General rules**

**Non-cumulation:** the degree prize cannot be combined with other Politecnico di Milano awards received for the same thesis.

**Payment:** the winners shall receive notification of being awarded the degree prize at their university e-mail address. Within 10 days of receiving said notification, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The prize shall be paid in a single payment by the Politecnico di Milano

**Waiver:** should the winner waive the prize or fail to return the forms by the set deadline, the prize shall be awarded to the next applicant in the ranking.

**Taxation:** the contributions awarded are subject to taxation, in accordance with applicable scholarship rules. The amount paid for the degree prize shall be treated as employment income for tax purposes. The costs borne by the Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the amount of the degree prize.

The Politecnico di Milano (hereafter also **Politecnico**), in the role of Data Controller, with registered address in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management -, hereby informs you of the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and respective implementing regulations (hereafter the **Regulation**).

#### **A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED**

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico include **(a)** the data provided by you during registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, residence, telephone and email contacts, academic qualifications; **(b)** the data collected in your application, in particular relating to your academic career, your academic qualification, as well as the information contained in your thesis.

#### **B. PURPOSES AND METHODS OF PROCESSING**

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data shall be processed by the Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with the legislation in force.

#### **C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF DATA PROVISION**

You have the right to:

to rectify any of your personal data that are incorrect or incomplete pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (*right to rectification*)

to restrict the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 18 of the Regulation (*right to restriction*);

to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
