HAVING REGARD to Presidential Decree 28.12.2000, no. 445;

HAVING REGARD to Articles 2 and 12 of Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, “Equal treatment in the right to university studies”;

HAVING REGARD to the Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued by Rector’s Decree no. 828 ref. no. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and in particular Art. 75 and 79;

HAVING REGARD to the letter, ref. no. 0113226 of 02/05/2022, with which the attorneys Paolo Benzi and Matteo Santantonio of the Company Dalmine S.p.A. manifested the intention to donate, merely for charitable purposes, to Politecnico di Milano, the sum of €36,456.00 aimed at promoting study activity in the field of engineering through the payment of 12 scholarships entitled “Roberto Rocca”, intended for students enrolled in the a.y. 2021/2022 on the 1st and 2nd year of the Master’s degree course in Engineering at Politecnico di Milano;

HAVING REGARD to Managerial Decree no. 4730/2022 ref. no. 120386 of 11/05/2022 which declares to accept the donation provided by the company Dalmine S.p.A.;

DECREES

The issuance of the call for applications for **12 “Roberto Rocca” scholarships** a.y. 2021/2022.

Art. 1

Recipients and characteristics of the scholarships

The 12 scholarships of €2,800.00 gross each, net of costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, are intended for **students enrolled in the a.y. 2021/2022 on Master’s degree courses in Engineering at Politecnico di Milano.**

Art. 2

Admission requirements

The scholarships are broken down as follows:

Art. 3 **How to participate**

Applicants are required to submit the application by way of the specific function available from Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri [Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits]) **by 12pm (Italian time) on 22 July 2022.**

Applicants must attach, via the specific procedure, in PDF format with a maximum of 5 MB:

1. Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum

The files must be named as Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Rossi-Mario-CV.pdf)

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application (state:closed), the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment procedure.

Art. 4 **Assignment of the scholarship**

The assignment of the scholarship will be decided by a Selection Committee appointed after the call deadline by management decree.

An initial ranking will be formulated for each category, taking account of the financial status, giving priority to the applicant in the most disadvantaged economic conditions.

To that end, the **valid and compliant 2021 ISEE** (equivalent **ISEEU** for those not earning income in Italy), found in the University's **database by the call deadline** will be considered.

In the absence of a valid and compliant **2021 ISEE** (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator)/**ISEEU** the student will be **attributed**, solely for the purposes of this ranking, the **highest ISEE/ISEEU (€95,001)**.

In the case of equal scores, the youngest applicant will be favoured.

The top 12 applicants of each category will be admitted to undergo interview (in the presence or online) with the Selection Committee in order to assess the cross-sectional skills and expertise possessed.

The final ranking will be prepared by the Selection Committee based upon the outcome of the interview.

The calendar of interviews will be communicated following the publication of the first ranking.

The interviews will be held, in Italian, in the month of September.

The interviews in the presence, will be in di Dalmine (BG), p.za Caduti 6 luglio 1944, n.1.

The Selection Committee may not assign all scholarships or part of them, if all or part of the applicants are not considered suitable.

The winners may be invited to a get-to-know meeting with the donor.

Art. 5 **General rules**

Accumulation: The scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships or other forms of financial aid provided by the Politecnico for the academic year relating to this call for applications. The scholarship, on the other hand, may be combined with the Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits, and with the international mobility contributions provided by the Politecnico or by other public or private entities. The scholarship may also be combined with exemptions from mandatory university fees and contributions.

Allocation: the winners will be notified of the award of the scholarship to their official University e-mail address. The awardees must duly sign and send the forms attached to the award notification within 10 days of receipt thereof, as confirmation of acceptance.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

Withdrawal: if the successful applicant opts out of the scholarship or if the necessary forms are not returned by the relevant deadline, the next eligible applicant in the ranking will be assigned the scholarship instead.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary. It will be revoked in any case if the beneficiary withdraws from his or her studies or transfers to another university during the year.

Tax status: the payments awarded are subject to taxation, under the legislation in force regarding study awards. The scholarship award is treated as employment income, and is therefore treated in the same way for tax purposes. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate amounting to 8.5% of the amount of the scholarship.

Self-certification of data: if controls by the Politecnico di Milano establish that the information supplied was false, all benefits obtained will be withdrawn

PRIVACY POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The Politecnico di Milano (henceforth also **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management, hereby informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and related implementing regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

The Processor of the data provided by you is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** the data collected upon submitting your application, particularly those relating to your academic career in number of university credits and average.

B. DATA PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in section B point 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide them will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. SCOPE OF CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call. **Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.**

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA STORAGE PERIOD

Your personal data will be stored only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:
obtain information on the methods by which your data are processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (so-called *right of access*)
to rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (so-called *right to rectification*)
to restrict the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 18 of the Regulation (so-called *right to restriction of processing*);
to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation (so-called *right to object*)
