HAVING REGARD to the Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued with Rector’s Decree no. 828, ref. no. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and in particular Art. 75 and 79;
HAVING REGARD to the letter, ref. no. 0018802 of 26/01/2023 relates to donation to Politecnico di Milano the sum of €1,085.00 to pay for a degree award in the name of Noemi Basso, intended for graduates of Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Architecture programmes at Politecnico di Milano;
HAVING REGARD to Managerial Decree no. 1146/2023 Protocollo 21588/2023 of 30/01/2023, which declares to accept the donation;
CONSIDERING the sum of €1,085.00 made available by Prof. Elsa Garavaglia using the funds in her possession;

D E C R E E S

to issue the call for the “**Noemi Basso**” - year **2023 degree award**.

Art.1 Introduction

Noemi Basso, was a **brilliant student** of Politecnico di Milano on the Building Architecture programme and then an **excellent** PhD graduate. She continued her career **in Japan obtaining the prestigious role of lecturer** at Waseda University in Tokyo, continuing to collaborate with Politecnico di Milano in the research topics dear to her, such as the architecture-structure relationship, structural reliability and seismic vulnerability.

Thanks to the initiative of Prof. Elsa Garavaglia and the family, the degree award has been created in her memory.

Art. 2 Characteristics of the award and recipients

The award, of the value of €2,000.00 gross and net of costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, will be granted to the degree thesis considered the best among those submitted

on the topic “*Architecture-Structure relationship in new building design and in the recovery of existing architecture*”.

Students who have obtained the following Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) qualifications from Politecnico di Milano are eligible to participate:

- in
 - Architettura e Disegno Urbano – Architecture and Urban Design
 - Architettura- Ambiente Costruito-Interni-Architecture-Built Environment-Interiors
 - Architettura - Architettura delle Costruzioni
 - Architectural Design and History – Progettazione Architettonica e Storia
 - Sustainable Architecture and Landscape Design – Architettura Sostenibile e Progetto del Paesaggio
 - Ingegneria Edile-Architettura (single-cycle five-year course)
- over the period from January 2022 to December 2022
- with marks of no less than 107/110

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met, using the Politecnico di Milano’s digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in the Politecnico di Milano’s digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

Art. 3 **How to participate**

Applicants are required to submit the individual application by way of the specific function available from online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **by 12 noon (Italian time) on 03 March 2023.**

Candidates must, by way of the relevant procedure:

- **attach the abstract of the thesis** in A4 format max 1 vertical page in pdf format of maximum 5 MB;
- **indicate the link to a cloud storage folder** which must contain:
 - **no. 1 table** presenting/summarising the thesis project in horizontal A4 format saved in PDF in high definition max. 20 MB
 - **up to a maximum of 3 tables** of the degree thesis significant for understanding the project saved in PDF(e.g. : layout, structure, plans-sections, relationship between structure and architecture, etc.).

The files must be named with Surname-First Name-Documents Type.format (for example, Rossi-Mario-abstract.pdf)

The folder, containing the attachments useful for the assessment, must be named with the Surname-First Name of the applicant.

Please check that the link to the folder can actually be used by the

Committee, that it has no expiry date and no access restrictions and that it is not damaged.

The documents must be uploaded to the cloud by the deadline of the call and must no longer be modified, under penalty of exclusion from the evaluation.

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that they have properly completed the procedure.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be edited. The applicant may delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this call.

The following circumstances shall involve exclusion from the assessment procedure:

- failure to close the application and/or incompleteness of the same;
- inadequacy of the documents submitted;
- an unusable link;
- documents uploaded or modified in the cloud storage after the deadline of the call.

For theses with several authors, each co-author intending to compete for the award must present individually their application for participation.

If, on the condition the requirements set out in Art. 1 of the call are in place, several applicants are in possession of equivalent qualifications, the Committee may split the award amount between them.

By submitting an application, the winning applicant consents to their thesis or part thereof being published within the bounds of respect for copyright.

Art. 4 **Selection Committee**

The ranking will be prepared by a Selection Committee appointed after the expiry of the call by managerial decree.

In forming the ranking, the Committee will consider only annexes uploaded by way of the specific procedure.

Preference will be given to topics developed *with structural nature*.

If the Selection Committee considers that none of the theses submitted by the competitors are suitable, the award will not be granted.

The winner may be invited to meet the donors.

Art. 5 **General rules**

Accumulation: the degree award may not be accumulated with other awards received by Politecnico di Milano for the same thesis.

Payment: the awarding of the degree award will be communicated to the winner via their official University email address. Within 10 days of receiving that communication, the winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

The award will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

Withdrawal: if the winner withdraws or fails to return the necessary forms by the set deadline, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Tax status: the payments awarded are subject to taxation, under the legislation in force regarding study awards. The amount paid as a degree award is income considered similar to income from employment, and as such is subject to the same taxation. The taxes paid by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the total degree award.

Art. 6 **Person Responsible for the Procedure**

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 5 of Italian Law, 7 August 1990, no. 241, the person responsible for this call for applications process is Dr Ivano Ciceri.

PRIVACY POLICY IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The Politecnico di Milano (henceforth also **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, hereby informs you about the methods of processing of your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 with regard to the protection of personal data and respective implementing regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** data collected upon submission of your application, in particular, data related to your academic career, the degree programme you have completed, and the data contained in your degree thesis.

B. PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR OPTIONAL DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in section B point 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide them will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. DATA COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION

Your personal data will be stored for the time strictly necessary to meet the requirements set forth by this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

obtain information on the methods by which your data are processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (so-called *right of access*)

to obtain the rectification of any of your personal data that are inaccurate pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (so-called *right to rectification*)

to restrict the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 18 of the Regulation (so-called *right to restriction*);

to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation (so-called *right to object*)
