HAVING REGARD TO Italian Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000;
HAVING REGARD TO Articles 2 and 12 of Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, “uniformity of treatment with regard to the right to university study”;
HAVING REGARD TO Article 75, paragraph 2 of the Politecnico di Milano Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting, issued with Rectoral Decree No. 828, protocol No. 7766 of 14/03/2014;
HAVING REGARD TO to letter ref. 0213427 of 19/09/2022, with which Marco Bissi, Legal Representative of the company Bissi Holding S.p.A., expressed the wish to gift, by way of donation, the sum of €2,500,00 to the Politecnico di Milano in order to establish No. 1 degree prize for graduates that have completed a thesis on topics related to the energy transition, the circular economy and renewable energy sources;
HAVING REGARD TO Managerial Decree No. 9678/2022 Ref. No. 221720 of 27/09/2022 with which the donation offered by Bissi Holding S.p.A. was accepted;

HEREBY DECREES

The enactment of the call for application for No. 1 **'Bissi Holding S.p.A.' 2022 degree prize.**

Art. 1

Description of the prize and recipients

The degree prize, with a value of €2,500.00 gross, inclusive of the charges to be paid by the Politecnico di Milano, shall be awarded to the best degree thesis that addresses topics relating to the: *“Energy Transition”*.

The call is open to students who have graduated with a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science):

1. from the Politecnico di Milano in one of the following subjects:
 - Energy Engineering - Ingegneria Energetica;
 - Management Engineering - Ingegneria Gestionale;
 - Ingegneria per l'Ambiente e il Territorio - Environmental and Land Planning Engineering;
 - Mechanical Engineering - Ingegneria Meccanica
 - Chemical Engineering - Ingegneria Chimica
2. During the period from December 2021 to December 2022

3. With a degree score no lower than 105/110
The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met using the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

Art. 2 **Application procedure**

Applicants must submit an application using the relevant function available within Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) by 12 pm (Italian time) **on 13 January 2023**.

Applicants must attach, through the appropriate procedure:

- the degree thesis in a PDF file no larger than 10 MB
- a summary of up to four A4 pages in a PDF file no larger than 5 MB

The file must be named in the format Surname-Forename-Type of document.pdf (for example Smith-John-Thesis.pdf)

Upon completion of the online application process (status:closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call itself.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the process has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of this call for applications.

Failure to complete the application, the submission of an incomplete application or the submission inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.

In the case of theses with multiple authors, each co-author that intends to apply for the award must submit an individual application.

In this case, all authors must submit identical documentation, as requested in Art. 2.

Should one or more of the co-authors not wish to participate, it shall be left to the applicant author to decide whether to contact them in the event of winning the prize.

Art. 3 **Selection Board**

The award of the degree prize shall be decided on the basis of a ranking list drawn up by a Selection Board appointed by managerial decree after the deadline of this call for applications.

In formulating the ranking, the Board shall make a decision on the basis of the attachments uploaded through the appropriate procedure and their relevance and significance to the topic indicated in Art. 1.

Preference shall be given to applicants that have completed work closely linked to the *analysis of energy development scenarios within the context of the energy transition*.
Provided that the requirements set out in Art. 1 of the call for applications have been met, the Board may award the prize to more than one candidate in the event of a tie.
The Selection Board may choose not to award the prize in the event that the applicants prove to be ineligible.

The winner(s) may be invited to meet with the donor.

Art. 4 **General rules**

Accumulation: this degree award cannot be combined with other Politecnico di Milano awards received for the same thesis.

Payment: the winner of the degree prize shall be notified through his/her university e-mail address. Within 10 days of receiving said notification, the winner must sign and return the relevant forms attached to the award notification.

The prize shall be disbursed by the Politecnico di Milano in a single payment.

Withdrawal: should the winner withdraw from the call or fail to return the forms within the deadline, the prize shall be awarded to the next applicant in the ranking.

Taxation: the prize shall be subject to taxation, in accordance with current legislation regarding scholarships. The amount paid by way of degree prize shall be treated as employment income for tax purposes and shall therefore be subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by the Politecnico di Milano correspond to the rate of regional tax on productive activity, amounting to 8.5% of the amount of the degree prize.

Art. 5 **Party responsible for the procedure**

In accordance with the provisions of Art. 5 of Italian Law No. 241 of 7 August 1990, the party responsible for this call procedure is Dr Ivano Ciceri.

PRIVACY POLICY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The Politecnico di Milano (hereinafter also Politecnico), in its capacity as Data Controller, with registered address in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, hereby informs you of the methods with which your personal data is processed, in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the corresponding implementing acts (hereinafter also the Regulation).

The Data Processor of the data you have provided is the Director of Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data concerning you collected and processed by the Politecnico are (a) the data provided by you at the time of registration or enrolment, including name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, home address, telephone and email contact details, academic qualifications; (b) the data collected when completing your application, in particular those relating to your academic career and the qualifications you have obtained, as well as the information contained in your thesis.

B. PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying the requirements for participation in the competition according to the criteria stated in this call for applications and all purposes provided for by law, including for statistical purposes

In relation to the aforementioned purposes, the data processing shall be carried out by the Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner that is relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are processed and, in any case, in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with the legislation in force.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes indicated in section B 1. is mandatory and any refusal to provide such data will result in the inadmissibility of the application submitted by the student and his/her immediate exclusion from the procedure.

D. SCOPE OF MOVEMENT AND DISCLOSURE OF THE DATA

Your personal data shall be disclosed to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process such data, namely natural or legal persons who work with the Politecnico for the purposes of implementing the procedures for the selection and awarding of the prize provided for by this call.

Your data will also be disclosed to the donor in order to inform the donor of the outcome of this call.

In the event of any contact made by the donor, then donor shall be understood to be a distinct and autonomous data controller in their own right. As such, the donor shall provide you with the relevant privacy policy.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data shall be stored at the Politecnico di Milano and shall not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data shall be retained only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period for archiving purposes in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, the Politecnico guarantees compliance with the principle of data minimisation pursuant to Art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation ('right to rectification')

to obtain a restriction of the processing of personal data concerning you, pursuant to Art. 18 of the Regulation ('right to restriction of processing');

to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods set forth in Art. 21 of the Regulation ('right to object')
