the issuing of a call for applications for **1 PhD thesis award known as “Prof. Florian Daniel” for the year 2025.**

art. 1

Degree award features and recipients

The award, in the sum of €1,000, included costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, will be awarded for the best PhD thesis among those addressing topics connected with: “Information Technology”.

Students may participate if they have achieved a PhD from Politecnico di Milano:

- in Ingegneria dell’Informazione-Information Technology
- in the period from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met, using the Politecnico di Milano’s digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in the Politecnico di Milano’s digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

art. 2

Admission requirements

Applicants must apply using the Online Services: <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **by 12 noon** (Italian time) on **30 May 2025**.

Applicants **must attach**, by way of the specific procedure, **in pdf format of a maximum 10 MB each**:

- the abstract of the PhD thesis
- list of publications
- curriculum vitae

Files must be named with Surname-First Name-Document Type.pdf (for example, Rossi-Mario-Thesis.pdf)

Upon completion of the online application process (status:closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call itself.

art. 3

Selection Committee

The granting of the award is decided based on a ranking drawn up by a Selection Committee appointed by managerial decree following the deadline of the call for applications.

In formulating the ranking, the Committee will decide on the basis of the documentation submitted by the applicants.

The Notice is open to all topics of Information Technology.

Preference will be given to applicants who have developed research oriented towards sustainable development and with a strong social impact.

Provided that the requirements set out in art. 1 of the call for applications are met, the Committee may share the award among several applicants if there is an ex-aequo.

The Selection Committee may not give the award if none of the applicants are deemed suitable.

The winner may be invited to an awards ceremony.

art. 4
General rules

Award combinations: the degree award cannot be combined with other awards received for the same thesis.

Withdrawal: if the winner withdraws or fails to return the necessary forms by the set deadline, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Payment: the degree award is paid in a lump sum. The award of the prize will be communicated to the winner, after publication of the final ranking, to the institutional email address. Within 10 days of receiving that communication, the winners must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance.

Taxation: the payments awarded are subject to tax, under applicable legislation on scholarships and degree awards. The amount paid as a degree award is income considered similar to income from employment, and as such is subject to the same taxation. The taxes paid by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the total degree award.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The Politecnico di Milano (henceforth also **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management , hereby informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and related implementing regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** data collected upon submission of your application, in particular, data related to your academic career, the degree programme you have completed, and the data contained in your degree thesis.

B. PROCESSING METHODS AND PURPOSES

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in section B point 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide them will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. SCOPE OF CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call. **Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.**

If any contact is made by a donor, this will be understood to be a separate and autonomous controller which will provide to you the appropriate privacy notice.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data will be stored only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

obtain information on the methods by which your data is processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (access right)

rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (rectification right)

restrict the processing of your personal data under

Art. 18 of the Regulation (right to limit processing);

object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (right to object)
