The call for applications for **n. 2 scholarships" AIDIA sez.MI Agar Bonati Sorbatti' A.Y. 2024/2025 academic year.**

Art. 1

Scholarship features and recipients

A scholarship of the amount of euro 1750.00 and net of the charges borne by the Politecnico di Milano, is intended for female students enrolled in the year 2023/2024 in the second year of a **Master's Degree in Civil Engineering - Ingegneria Civile** at the **Politecnico di Milano**.

A scholarship of the amount of euro 1750.00 and net of the charges borne by the Politecnico di Milano, is intended for female students enrolled in the year 2023/2024 in the second year of a **Master's Degree in Mechanical Engineering- Ingegneria Meccanica** at the **Politecnico di Milano**.

Art. 2
Participation procedures

Candidates must submit the application using the online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generic[Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits] **by 12 noon (Italian time) on 16 May 2025.**

Applicants must attach, via the online procedure (maximum 5 MB each):

- **Curriculum Vitae**
- **Motivational letter**

The files must be named in the format Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Smith-John-Thesis.pdf)

Upon completion of the online application process (status: closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application (status: closed), applicants can print a receipt and no more changes can be made to the application. Applicants may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of the call for applications.

Failure to complete the application, the submission of an incomplete application or the submission of inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.

By submitting an application, the applicant agrees that the material submitted, or part of the same, may be disseminated in accordance with copyright.

Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met using the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

Art. 3

Selection Board

The award of the scholarships shall be decided on the basis of a ranking list drawn up by a Selection Board appointed by managerial decree after the deadline of this call for applications.

In formulating the ranking lists, the Board shall decide on the basis of the attachments uploaded via the online procedure and their relevance to the topics indicated in Article 1.

On the condition that the requirements set out in Art. 1 of the call for applications are met, the Board may award the scholarship to more than one candidate in the event of a tie.

The Selection Board may choose not to award the prize in the event that the none of the applicants is deemed eligible.

Winners may be invited to meet with the donor.

Art. 4

General rules

Combination: scholarships and any renewals may not be combined with other scholarships or financial assistance provided by Politecnico, especially the benefits of the Diritto allo Studio Universitario (DSU) programme, for the same academic year. Scholarships and any renewals may be combined with contributions for international mobility provided by Politecnico or other public or private entities. Scholarships and any renewals may be combined with exemptions from university tuition fees and contributions.

Disbursement: the assignment of the scholarship and any renewals will be announced to the winners using the University institutional email address.

The winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award or renewal notification, signed for acceptance within 10 days of receiving the notice.

Renewals will be paid annually from February.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not paid or the beneficiary fails to renew it, the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call.

Waiver: if the scholarship is waived or the winner fails to deliver the forms, the assignment will be transferred to the next suitable candidate in the ranking.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

If the scholarship is revoked, the beneficiary must return what has been paid to Politecnico di Milano and the amount will be used to establish a new call.

Self-certification: any detection of false declarations by Politecnico di Milano will result in the forfeiture of the received benefits.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship payment is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (hereafter *Politecnico*), as Data Controller, with its registered office in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Directorate - informs about personal data processing methods under EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementing regulations (hereafter the *Regulation*).

The data processing Controller is the Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

Your data collected and processed by Politecnico is **(a)** provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** collected upon submission of your application, particularly related to your academic career and financial status.

B. PROCESSING METHODS AND PURPOSES

Your data may be processed for the following purposes:
for the public interest in verifying eligibility for participation under the criteria outlined in this call for applications, and for all other legal purposes, including statistical analysis.

Data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which data is processed, and to guarantee security and confidentiality in compliance with applicable legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in paragraph B point 1 is mandatory, and refusing to provide it will result in inadmissibility of the student's application and immediate exclusion from the procedure.

D. COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION OF DATA

Your data will be disclosed to authorised Politecnico employees for processing, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call.

Your data will be disclosed to the donor to inform them of the call outcome.

If any contact is made by the donor, they will be considered a separate and independent data controller. The donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to any third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your data will be stored for the time strictly necessary to meet the requirements set forth by this call, unless it needs to be stored for a longer period in the public interest. If the data is stored for longer periods, Politecnico will follow the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

obtain information on data processing methods and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (*access right*)

rectify any of your personal data if inaccurate under Art. 16 of the Regulation (*rectification right*)

restrict the processing of your data under

Art. 18 of the Regulation (*right to restrict processing*);

object to the processing of your data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
